- ✓ The Emergency Food Assistance Program (TEFAP) provides shelf-stable products, along with a grocery cart of nutritious food, including fresh produce and protein.
- ✓ Our Baby Emergency Food Box Program provides formula or food for children up to 12 months of age; diapers are provided when available. Proof of age/birth certificate is required.
- ✓ As available, the Commodity Supplemental Food Program (CSFP) provides shelf-stable food and fresh groceries for seniors aged 60 years and older who live in the Desert Mission Food Bank service area and meet federal poverty-level guidelines.

Living Well participants focus on achieving total well-being through connection to community resources and public benefits. We help to uncover the root causes of food insecurity and provide direct connections to resources from basic needs to asset-building. Community Service Specialists meet one-on-one with participants to identify goals and address common barriers to achieving success.

- ✓ Community resource navigation. Benefits eligibility and assistance.
- ✓ Community Nutrition Education (on-site and digital): Provides interactive classes, nutritious recipes, cooking demonstrations, and food literacy education.
- ✓ Mobile Farm Stand: Brings affordable, farm-fresh organic produce directly to community locations across Phoenix and Scottsdale.
- ✓ The Garden Program encourages growing fresh, healthy fruits and vegetables on-site and in the community. Free fall and spring gardening classes are available.
